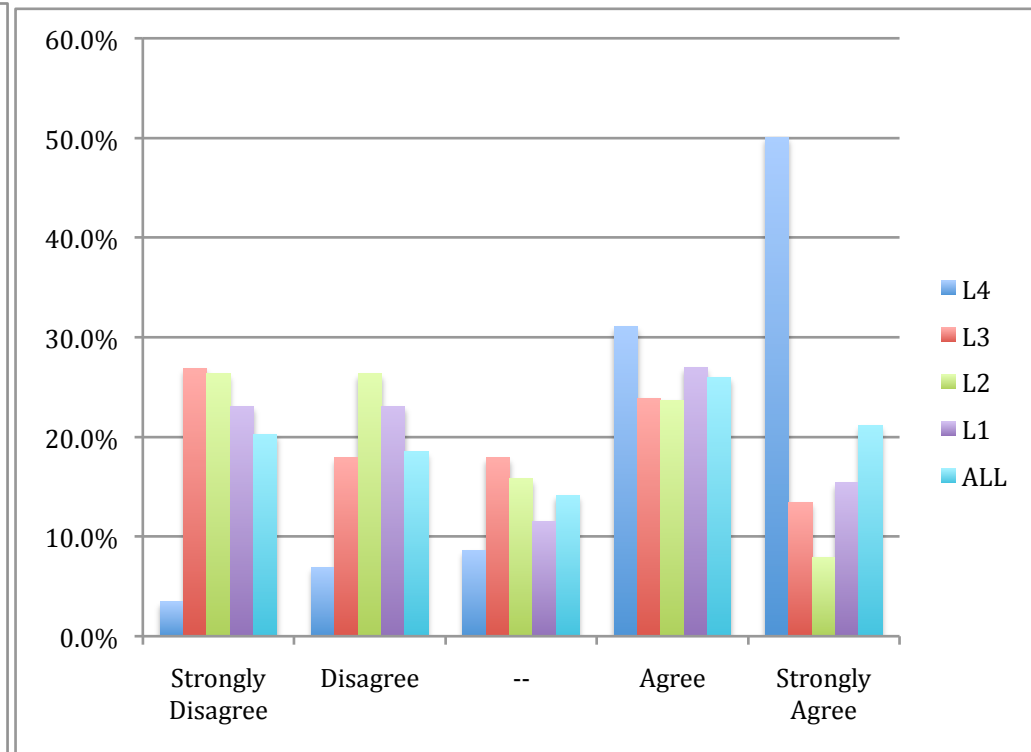
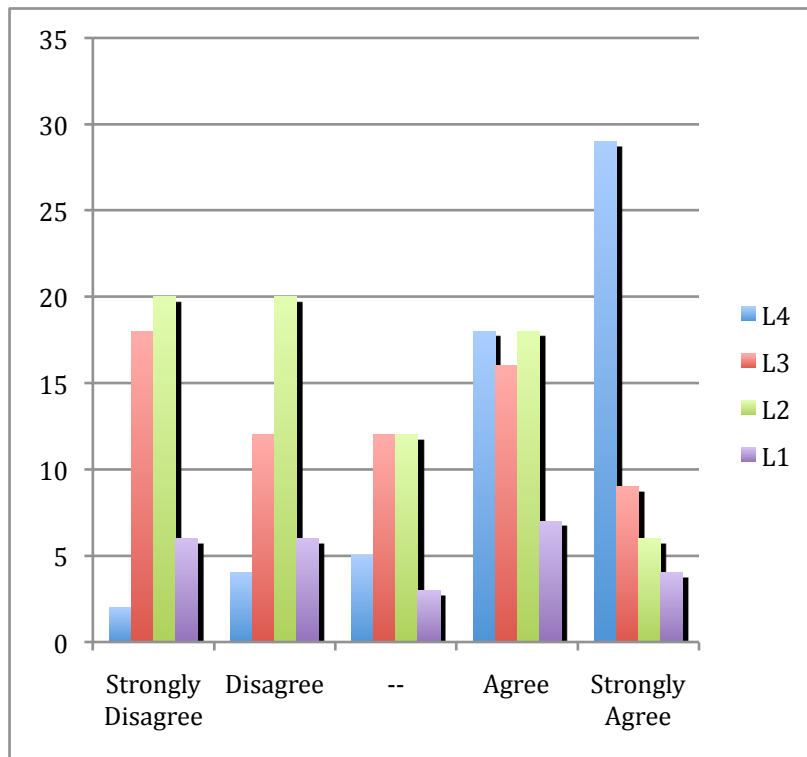

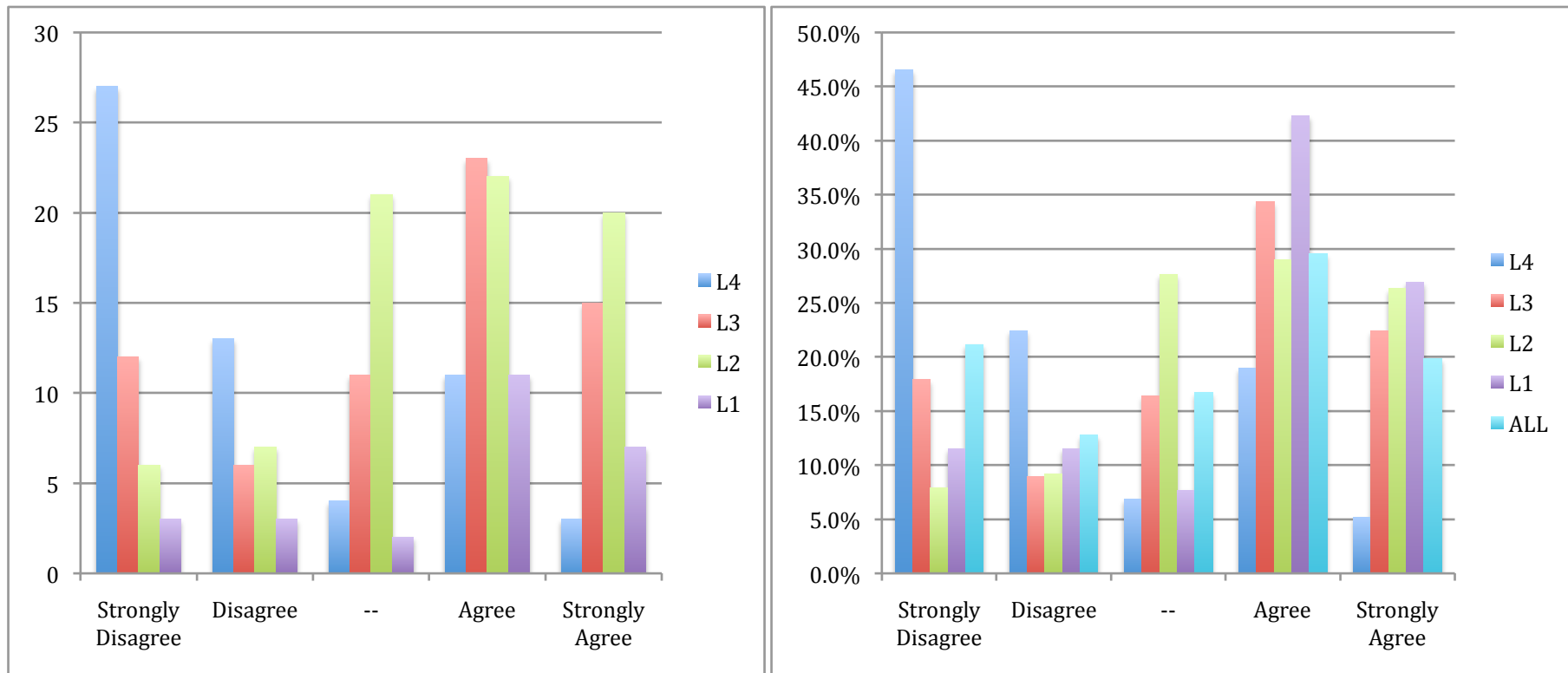

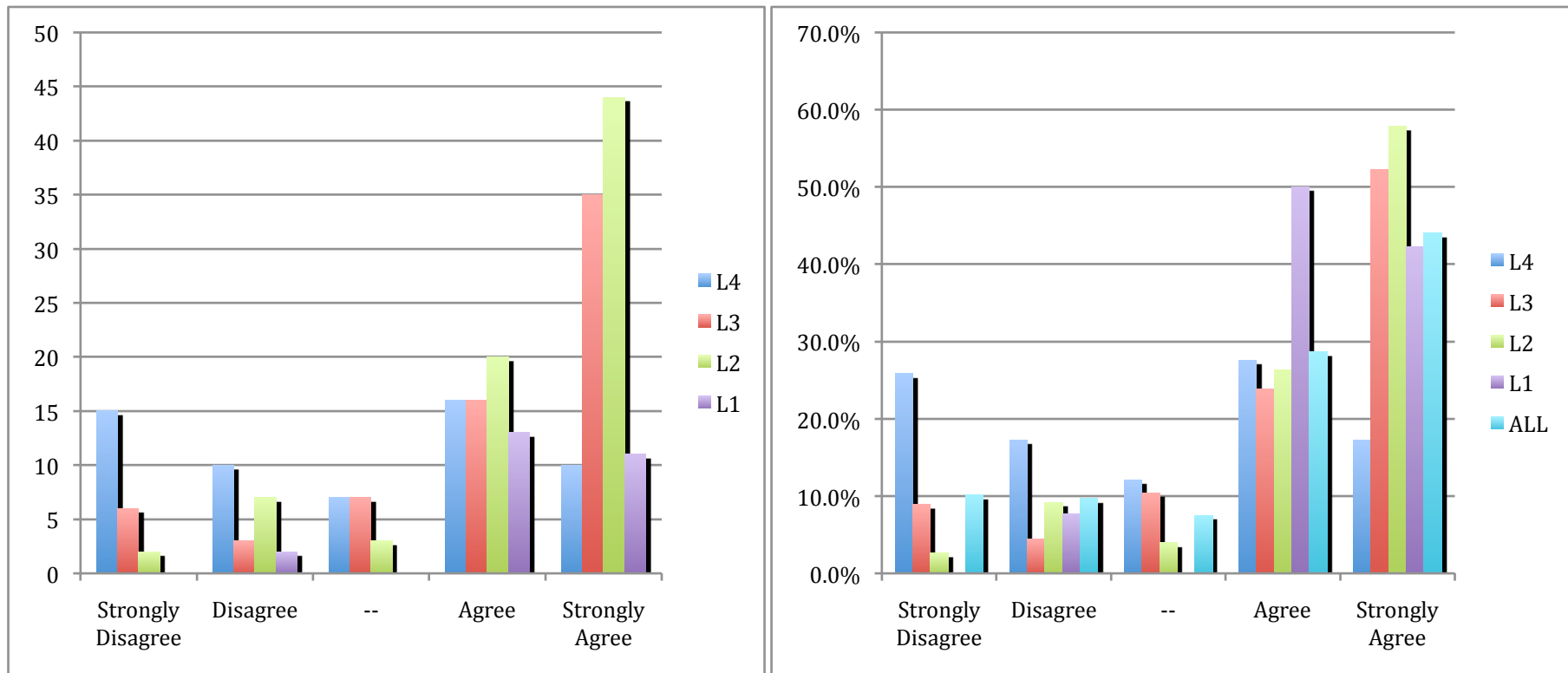


NOTES: Around half agree/strongly agree that the pass rate should be made but a very high proportion of L4's strongly disagree.

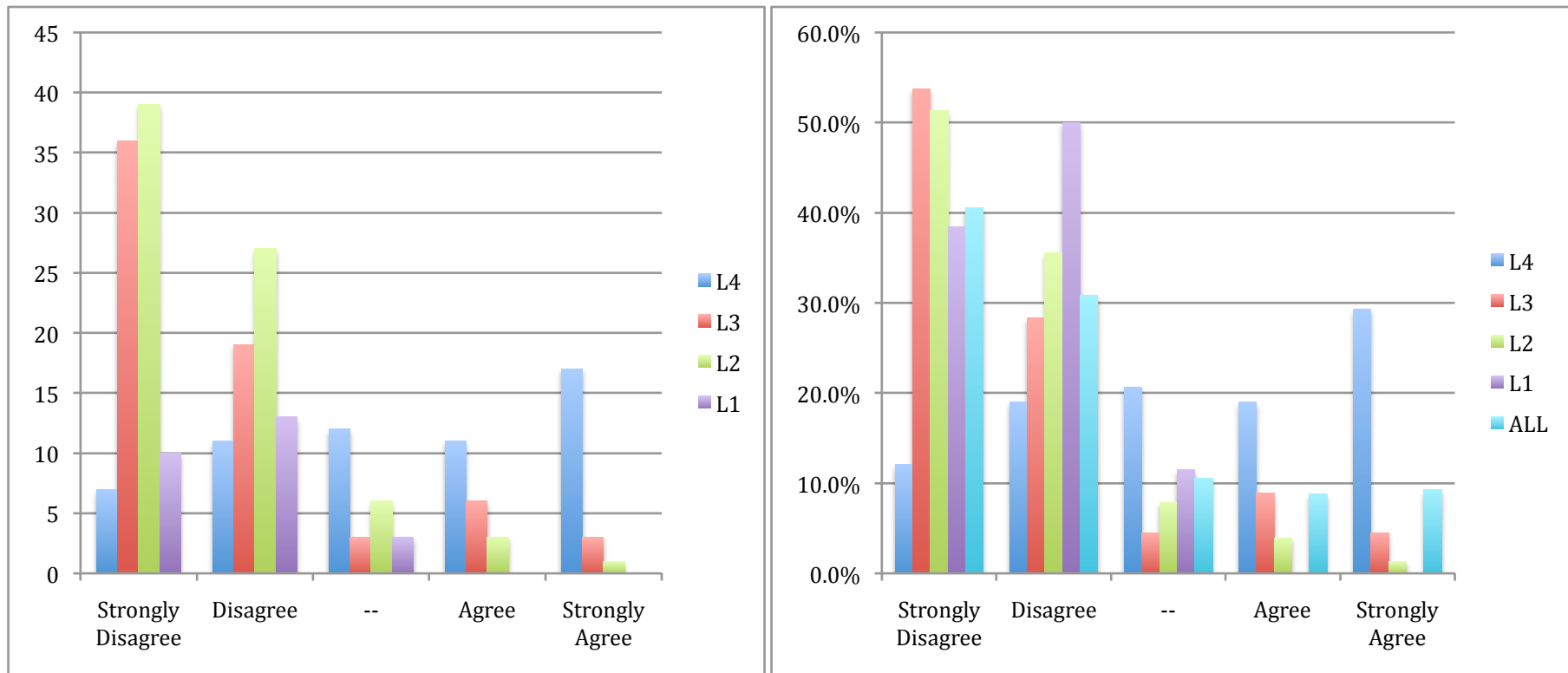


NOTES: 72% agree/strongly agree that there should be an age allowance including a much larger percentage of L4's than in the previous question.

No, The Eurotest is fine as it is and needs no changes at all

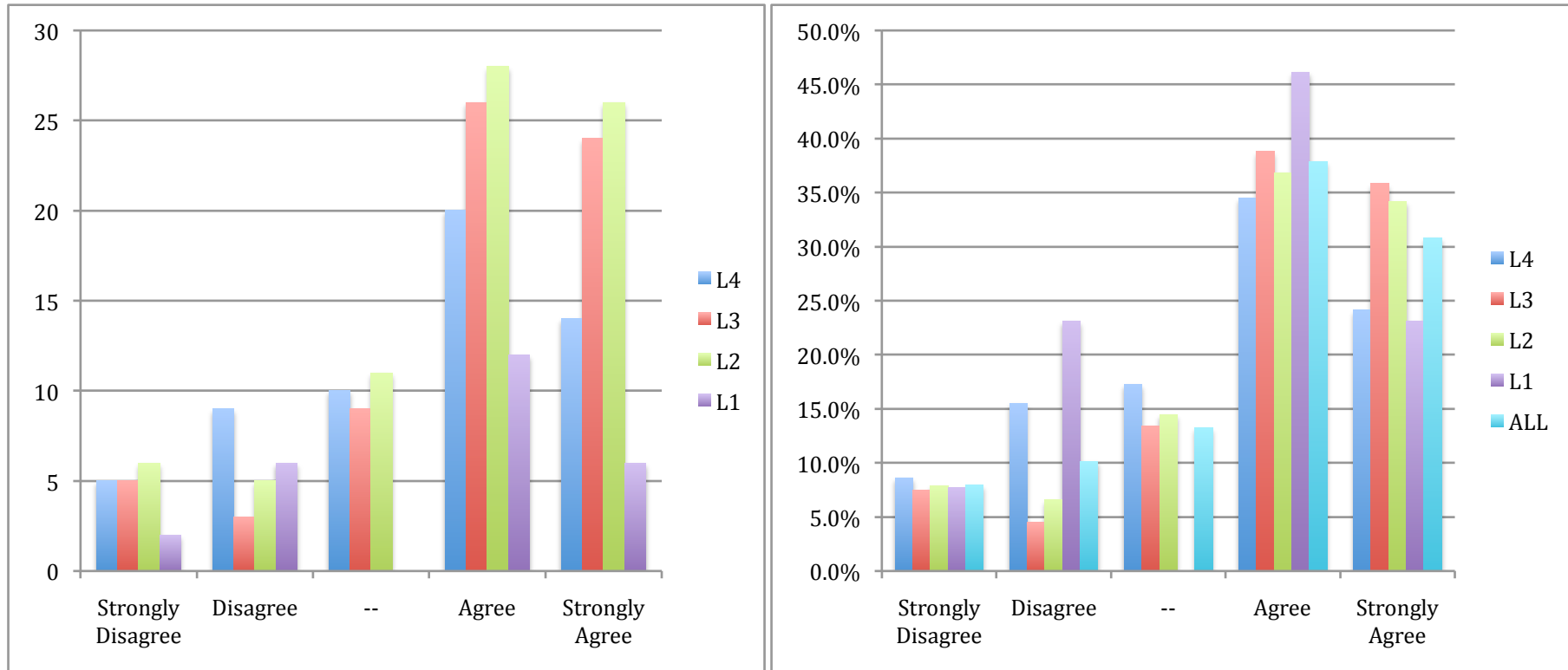
